
Assessment of Commercial Rafting Rivers

Overview

On April 25th, 2015 a massive 7.8 magnitude earthquake struck Nepal. The epicenter was in Gorkha district, west of Kathmandu. Hundreds of aftershocks affected the region.

Another major 7.3 magnitude earthquake struck on May 12th. This time the epicenter was bordering Dolakha and Sindhupalchowk, to the east of Kathmandu. Again hundreds of aftershocks continued to affect the region for several weeks.

Over 9000 people were killed in these quakes with more than 23000 people seriously injured. Long term relief and recovery efforts will be ongoing as Nepal's rural communities most affected continue to rebuild. Tourism will be an integral part of this recovery.

Affect on Rafting Industry

NARA has taken several months to carefully assess all of the Rivers officially open for commercial Rafting in Nepal. Several members of NARA and HRGAN have scouted and successfully operated commercial trips during the months of October & November 2015.

As of December 1st, 2015 it is our great pleasure to conclude that all of the Rivers listed above are open and considered safe for commercial Rafting and Kayaking in Nepal.

Though several of the Rivers mentioned above lie inside the most earthquake affected districts, the Rivers themselves remain open for recreational use. There have been minor changes to water flow and rapids on some Rivers which is typical after seasonal affects of monsoon, but no severe changes or unacceptable hazards have been found.
